Funds

This program offers awards up to \$1,500 to empower you to play an active role in turning your idea into reality.

Mentorship

You will be matched with a professional in the community who will be your mentor and thought partner, offering you guidance as you work toward new goals.

Growth

You will participate in an orientation and three workshops (November 2020-May 2021) that will give you the opportunity to learn, meet other teens, and gain skills and inspiration as you develop your project.



Am I Eligible?



To qualify for a Julie Beren Platt Teen Innovation Grant, you must:

- \bigstar Be entering 8th-12th grade and not yet a high school graduate.
- ★ Live in the Greater Los Angeles area.
- ★ Submit fully completed application by Friday, September 17, 2020.

FYI: The lead teen of each project must identify as Jewish.

If applying as a team, select 1-2 teens to complete application and participate in Orientation and Discovery Workshops.
